



### **Library Rules**

- Students should Keep Silence in the Library. Mobile Phones should be kept in "Silent Mode" while using Library.

- Maximum number of Books that can be issued is 2.
- Periodicals and Reference Books will not be issued and may be consulted only in the Library.
- ⇒ A Book must be returned in the same condition in which it was issued.
- → Absence from the Institute will not be accepted as an excuse for the delay in returning of books.
- No reminders will be given to individual defaulters, but a consolidated list of defaulters will be displayed on the NOTICE BOARD.
- ➡ Books/Old Magazines will be issued to Identity Card holders only.
- □ In case of marking / underlining of books, the cost of the latest edition of the book will be charged from the student.
- Any violation of the above Rules shall attract disciplinary action.

## Rules and Regulations for the Hostel Residents

HIDT welcomes our new students. Here, we look forward for an amicable existence in a friendly and disciplined environment. The rules stated as under are not to restrict the lifestyle goals of an individual. In fact, they are supportive towards adaptive and conducive approach to evolve as a student as eventually the students will step into a competitive world where discipline is the base of stability.

- ⇒ Hostel facility is available only for the outstation students.
- ⇒ All hostel charges are payable in advance for each Semester. Delay in the submission of the fee is liable to financial penalty.
- Under no circumstances a Student is allowed to see a visitor other than whose Photograph has been submitted as the local guardian duly signed by the parents(on Saturday & Sunday between 10.00 am to 5.00 p.m. only). As far as possible every student of the Hostel should have a guardian in Dehradun.
- The parents are advised to submit complete and verified information about their residential address and contact information while getting their ward admitted to the hostel. Any changes if any in the later course should be duly informed to the warden. It is then the Warden's responsibility to get the details updated in the Institute's record.
- Students should maintain cleanliness in hostel premises.
- The students can go to their local guardians(LG) twice a month on for an overnight stay from Friday evening and be back by Sunday evening before the roll call (7.30 pm in summers and 6.00 pm during winters). It is compulsory that LGs come in person to take their ward for outing.
- The students will be allowed home outings twice in a semester. In case of an emergency, a request from the parent has to be made and notified with the Principal, Warden and the respective class teacher. If student overstays at home or does not attend classes while being in hostel on any aspect, the authorities are liable to take strict disciplinary action.
- Students after reaching their home towns have to inform the warden about their safe arrival. At the same time, it is duly parent's responsibility to inform the hostel authorities about their ward's departure date, time and the mode of transport from home town.
- ➡ Before leaving from the hometown, a request letter duly signed by the parents and the permission to send the ward to hometown is absolutely mandatory.
- Students are permitted to go to the market once on a weekday as per their requirement and on Saturdays and Sundays. However, they need special permissions duly signed by the subject teacher in case of procurement of course materials for weekday's outing. In case of a gazetted holiday, a student can avail an outing but the restricted outings will be limited to 3 times in a week.
- No student is permitted to enter the Hostel Kitchen or talk to the Catering Staff. Any complaints regarding quality of food, etc are to be made to the incharge of Mess Committee/Warden or directly to the principal. A complaint/suggestion register will be maintained to cater to grievances related to food or any other issues. The register will be monitored by the hostel committee and the administration.

- Students are not allowed to use heaters, immersion rods, electric iron etc in the dormitory. Any student found doing so will be fined accordingly. However, students will be provided with plug points outside the dormitories to cater to instant food needs like warm water etc. cooking under no circumstances is allowed inside the dormitory.
- The main gate of the hostel will close at 7.00 pm in summers and at 6.00 pm in winters. The students are instructed to be in the premises before the respective closure time. In case of delay, the parents of the students should be informed via sms or a telephone call.
- No student will be permitted to stay back in the hostel during the study hours of the Institute. Only in a medical condition, the student maybe allowed to stay back with proper notification by the Warden to the Principal, respective faculty of the Institute as well as the parents.
- Day Scholars will not be allowed to visit the hostel premises.
- No refund will be applicable if a student decides to leave the hostel in the middle of a session.
- In case of any medical emergency, all possible help and assistance will be provided to the sick student.
- The Institute will not bear any medical expenses of the resident student. In a medical condition if the student needs medical attention, the cost will be borne by the student.
- The Institute will not be responsible for any loss/theft of the belongings of the students.
- ⇒ It is expected from the resident students to keep their dormitories clean maintain civic sense and cooperate
  in quality and hygienic living. Also, they are expected to conduct themselves with proper decorum and courtesy
  in the dorms and dining area.

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the Institute as well as in the hostel. It is a punishable offence. Any student or students found indulging in this activity will be immediately expelled for the Institute.

- The Institute authorities (administration and the hostel committee) will conduct surprise checks/ inspection periodically. The students of the best kept dormitory will be reward for their endeavour.
- Any damage done to the hostel property by a student will invite a disciplinary action and will be liable for financial penalty for the damage caused.
- Parents/Visitors can have meals at applicable rates when they come to visit their ward. No visitor is allowed to stay in the hostel beyond stipulated visiting hours.

### **Admission Process**

Successful applicants called for admission should bring original and attested copies of the following documents at the time of admission counseling.

- (a) Proof of age on the certificate of High School.
- (b) Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate. (to be submitted in original)
- (c) Character and Conduct Certificate.
- (d) Proof of passing the qualifying examination together with mark sheet in accordance with the eligibility requirements for admission.
- (e) Two passport size photographs for the identity card.
- (f) Domicile Certificate/Mool Niwas Praman Patra.
- (g) Permanent Address Certificate / Aadhar Card.
- (h) Certificate from a Government Hospital/Civil Surgeon/Government Doctor about the Blood Group/Medical Fitness Certificate.
- (i) Duly filled Hostel Admission Form, if opted for Hostel accommodation.
- (j) Fill Anti Ragging Affidavits online by logging on to www.ANTIRAGGING.IN or www.AMANMOVEMENT.ORG . Student should submit a hard copy of the Affidavit to the Administration. It is mandatory for all the students granted admission.

## **Cancellation of Admission**

- (i) If the information furnished by the applicants at the time of admission is found to be incorrect/misleading, his/her admission may be cancelled at any time.
- (ii) In case, the certificates of the qualifying examination are not submitted by the applicant at the time of admission and later on it is found that the applicant does not fulfill the eligibility criteria, then his/her admission in the Institute shall stand immediately and automatically cancelled. In such cases the Institute shall not refund the fee submitted by such applicant.

## **Summer Internship**

The Institute organizes field oriented Industry interface and summer internship programmes for final year students. This internship provides hands-on practical exposure to various functions/domains of corporate world and equip them with required skills of corporate management. The Institute has tied-up with prestigious public sector and corporate organizations for summer training internship. For completion of internship the students are required to submit a project/Training Report.

## **Rules & Regulations**

- We are very particular about 80% attendance in the classes. Students will not be allowed to go on leave, unless there is an extreme necessity and acceptable reason (s). Under special circumstances, a few days leave can be allowed but no benefit of leave will be given in the counting of attendance or for any other purpose related to examination, evaluation process & Scholarship purpose.
- Faculties are fully empowered to disallow a late comer from attending class or from any other activity of the School.
- Students have to observe discipline and follow all the rule and Regulations relating to Campus, Library, Hostel /Mess, Canteen and other general rules of the Institute.
- A Progress Report of weak students about their Attendance and Performance shall be displayed on the Notice Board and a copy of the same shall be sent to their parent / guardians for information, if found necessary.
- The students will have to wear uniform as prescribed by the HIDT.
- Each student will be issued an Identity Card with his / her photograph and countersigned by the Director. The students must carry their Identity Cards with them for verification at all times, that should be produced before the authority, as and when demanded from them.
- Use of cell phones are permitted subject to the restrictions in class rooms, library, computer lab, dining hall, etc.
- Any student violating the above Rules and Regulations could be penalized, even to the extent of expulsion from the Program.
- No Student of HIDT shall indulge in any act of indiscipline which includes:
- Misconduct/ Misbehavior.

- Violation of rules and regulations of discipline.
- Breach of an undertaking.
- Refusal to obey the directions of competent authorities.
- Physical violence or use of abusive language.
- Destroying or defacing of HIDT property.
- Organizing a procession or meeting without the permission of the appropriate authority.
- Rowdy or other forms of misbehavior.
- Making false statement with a view to affect the impartiality of action by an officer or to impute malice or create public opinion against him/her or with any other malicious motive.
- Participation in activities such as Gherao, Dharna and Pradarshan; Use of derogatory slogans, abuses and propaganda.
- Disrupting the smooth running of the Institute or environment conducive to studies or harmonious relationship between different people living on the Campus.
- Refusal to establish or reveal identity.
- Non-payment of HIDT fees or other dues including Mess and Canteen charges.
- Attempting to commit an act of indiscipline, as betting, an act of indiscipline, inciting others to commit an act of indiscipline, individually or jointly with others.
- Disrupting or preventing teaching, study, examination, extra-curricular activities, office working etc.
- Arriving late in classes.
- Sending obscene/lewd/nasty SMS/MMS (Short Messaging Services and Multi Media Services).

### **General Rules**

- Over-speeding and improper parking of vehicles inside the Campus.
- 3 Student must avoid smoking, chewing of tobacco/ Gutka/ Pan Masala or chewing gum, and consumption of alcohol, within the campus and hostel. Consumption of these products within the campus is prohibited. Students are advised to refrain from indulging in these habits even when away from the campus.
- **7** Student must avoid use of cell phones in 'ringing mode' during class hours. In exceptional circumstances, urgent/ emergency calls may be taken with permission of concerned faculty.
- Avoid entry in prohibited areas like mess cookhouse, electric panel room, sewage treatment plant etc.
- Avoid use of Polyethylene bag in the campus.
- Students are required to attend the classes and complete your assignments regularly. Your 100% attendance is solicited. However, some relaxation may be allowed to attend health problems and other genuine exigencies.
- Students entry to the campus and exit from the campus will be monitored. You should carry your ID-Card with you all the time.
- During academic sessions, students are required to be present in your respective classrooms. Student will not be allowed to leave the Institute's premises during class hours.
- Student should maintain cordial relations amongst themselves, with their faculty and staff members.

### UGC Regulations on Curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009

- Students shall adhere to the norms regarding ANTI-RAGGING LAWS laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India are:
  - According to the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India ragging includes "disorderly behavior/ treatment with fellow student whether by words, spoken or written or by any act which has the effect of teasing, treating and handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or indecent activities, which may cause or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension there off in a fresher or a junior student."
- For information, some of the punishments for students directly or indirectly involved in the ragging and it's abetment are as follows:
- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Suspension/expulsion from the college and or hostel or both.
- **7** Fine upto Rs.10,000/- .
- Lodging FIR/Police Action against an offender.

## **Dress Code**

Within campus, all the students are required to be decently dressed, with neat and clean uniform, duly prescribed by the HIDT. However, on Wednesday the students may report in decent casual dress.


